

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
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#### INTRODUCTION

**M/s East Venice Hotels And Resorts Pvt. Ltd** is a 'Star Hotel' project situated at Survey No. 6,6/2-3, 6/2-2, 6/2. at Allapuzha west village, Alappuzha District, Kerala. The construction project was accorded CRZ Clearance on 11-08-2017 vide File No. 11-19/2016-IA-III by Ministry of Environment, Forest and climate Change.

The half yearly compliance report needs to be submitted as part of general condition No.07 of Environmental Clearance order by the project proponent. The compliance report to conditions of the Environmental Clearance for the period of April 2021 - September 2**021** (First Half) is being submitted.



#### **PART - A – SPECIFIC CONDITIONS - CONSTRUCTION PHASE**

01The project proponent shall ensure that the guidelines for<br/>building and construction projects issued vide this Ministry's OM<br/>No.19-2/2013-IA.III dated 09.06.2015, are followed to ensure<br/>sustainable environmental managementComplete State<br/>Complete State

#### Compliance:

The project proponent is being complied guidelines for building and construction stipulated in OM No.19-2/2013-IA.III dated 09.06.2015 issued by the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change. The solid wastes, liquid wastes, hazardous waste and construction wastes are handling as per the relevant rules published in 2016. These measures are being done under the supervision of NABET accredited Consultancy. To monitor all the aspects related to sustainable environment, the project proponent has constituted an Environment Monitoring Cell.

#### Compliance:

To conserve the coastal zone as such, the project proponent is being implemented all conditions / recommendations mentioned in vide their letter No. 2515/A3/16/KCZMA/S&TD, dated 30th April, 2016, of Kerala Coastal Zone Management Authority (KCZMA). The project proponent has constituted an internal committee to monitor the implementation of recommendations of KCZMA.

# 03The project proponent shall obtain all necessary clearance /<br/>permission from all relevant agencies including town planning<br/>authority before commencement of work.Complied

#### Compliance:

The project proponent has obtained all necessary clearances / permission from all relevant Departments and competent authorities. The lists of obtained clearances / permission / approvals are listed below. The conditions stipulated in the clearances / permissions are being strictly executed by the project proponent. The copies of relevant permissions and approvals are attached as **Annexure No. 1, 8, 9, 13 & 14.** All approvals are having adequate validity period. A brief list of approvals is provided below.

- 1. CRZ clearance
- 2. Building permit from Local Self Government
- 3. Consent to Establish from PCB
- 4. NOC form Ground water Department
- 5. NOC form Fire and rescue Services

04The construction in CRZ areas shall strictly in accordance with<br/>the provisions of CRZ Notification, 2011 and as amended from<br/>time to time.Noted

#### Compliance:

To adhere the provisions of CRZ Notification 2011 and amendments, the project proponent is having a regular contact with the accredited consultant to update with the relevant provision of CRZ Notification and its amendment. The project proponent scrupulously followed all the provisions stipulated in CRZ Notification, 2011 and as amended from time to time. The construction work is under process as plan submitted in KCZMA. The photograph of the current status of the building is attached as **Plate No.1**.

05Consent to Establish shall be obtained from State PollutionCompliedControl Board under the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution)Act, 1981 and the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act,1974, prior to commencement of work.

#### Compliance:

The CFE is mandatory to commence construction therefore the project proponent obtained consent to Establish from State Pollution Control Board before the commencement of construction activities. The copy of the same is attached as **Annexure No.9.** The construction work started only after the issuance of consent to establish by State pollution Control Board.

06There shall be no dressing or alteration of the sand dunes, natural<br/>features including landscape changes for beautification,<br/>recreation and other such purposeNoted

#### Compliance:

The condition is being compiled by the project proponent. As part of beautification, recreation and other such purpose, no topographical changes is being done in and around the project site. The project proponent will seek expert advice to create such landscape beautification, recreation and other such purposes for eco friendly development. The project proponent will not do any beatification or alteration work outside the project site to destroy the natural features.

07The development of resort / hotel shall be strictly for occupationNotedof tourist and visitors. There should not be any construction for<br/>residential purpose.Noted

#### Compliance:

The scope of the project does not have any change. The construction of Hotel and resort is progressing and it is only for the occupation of tourist and visitors not for residential purpose. The project proponent will not deviate from its plan to construct hotel cum resort. The construction project is progressing for tourist and visitors. The nature of project is mentioned in the building permit and Consent to establish of PCB which are attached as **Annexure No. 8 and 9.** The photograph of the current status is attached as **Plate No.1**.

08All waste (liquid and solid) arising from the proposed project shall<br/>be disposed off as per the norms prescribed by State Pollution<br/>Control Board. There shall not be any disposal of untreated<br/>effluent into the surface / coastal water bodies. Waste water<br/>generated shall be treated in STP and reused for landscaping,<br/>flushing, HVAC cooling or other purposes. The project proponent<br/>shall make alternate arrangement for situation arising due to<br/>malfunctioning of STP. Regular monitoring of the effluent from<br/>STP shall be carried out under intimation to the SPCB.Noted

#### Compliance:

The project proponent installed Sewage Treatment Plant with a cost of 10 lakh to reuse the waste water generated from the project site. The treated water will be used for landscaping, flushing, cooling tower and other purposes. No untreated effluent will let out to the surface / coastal water bodies. The project will enter into an agreement with STP supplier for timely maintenance of STP. Regular monitoring of effluent from STP will be conducted by a NABL approved laboratory. The project proponent is carrying out the monitoring in construction phase. The result of ambient air, noise and water is attached as **Annexure No. 10,11 &12.** 

The all waste generated from the project site is being disposed as per the rules published. The project proponent is keeping the project premises as a hygienic place by placing waste bins in appropriate places. All Municipal and liquid wastes generated from the proposed project shall be disposed off as per the provisions prescribed in Municipal Solid Waste Management and Handling Rules, 2016 and norms stipulated by State Pollution Control Board. The bio degradable waste will be managed in site by treating the waste with bio bins or biogas plant.

### 09No labour camp, machinery and material storage shall be erectedNotedin CRZ area.

#### Compliance:

The project proponent did not install any machinery, material storage spaces labors camp installed in the CRZ area. All such facilities are provided outside the CRZ area. The CRZ area is being preserved as such.

10The project proponent shall not undertake any construction within<br/>200 m in the landward side of High Tide Line and with in the area<br/>between Low Tide Line and High Tide Line. The proposed<br/>constructions shall be beyond 200 m from the HTL.Complied

#### Compliance:

The project proponent did not do any construction activity within 200 meters in the landward side of HTL. The construction work of hotel and resort is progressing as per plan submitted in KCZMA, the project proponent will construct the hotel cum resort at beyond 200 meter in the landward side of High Tide Line. There is no construction is planned in the area between Low tide Line and High Tide Line.

11There shall no ground water drawal within CRZ. Extraction of<br/>ground water shall be strictly carried out after obtaining prior<br/>permission from the Competent Authority and the extraction point<br/>shall be strictly from a point beyond CRZ.Complied

#### Compliance:

At present the project proponent is depending rain water and tanker water for construction purposes. The Project proponent won't draw ground water from CRZ area. The project had submitted its application to get prior permission to construct open well in the project site. The permission was granted by the Department of Ground water to dig a well. The extraction point of ground water is beyond CRZ limit. The NOC from Department of Ground water is attached as **Annexure No. 13.** The drawl of ground water is not permitted in CRZ area. Therefore the project proponent did not plan to dig a well or extract ground water in CRZ area.

12 The project proponent shall ensure compliance to all the safety Noted measures, as proposed for the project site, to meet any contingency during Tsunami or any such natural calamity including the construction of restaurant on stilts in the resort project site as assembling place as part of on-site emergency preparedness for all guests and staff within resort in case of any natural calamity.

#### Compliance:

The project has got initial NOC from Fire and rescue service and all conditions and guidelines are complied with. The project will install all necessary safety measures as proposed in the project site during its operational phase. These measures can face any contingency during Tsunami or any other natural calamity. An assembly point is earmarked there in the project site for all guests and staff within hotel cum resort in case of any disaster happens. The copy NOC form Fire and rescue service is attached as **Annexure No. 14.** The structural stability of the building is also up to mark to prevent possible earthquake. The project proponent has installed measures for firefighting equipments in construction phase. The all emergency phone numbers are exhibited in the project to get service in case of an emergency arises.

#### 13 Necessary arrangements for the treatment of effluents and solid Noted wastes must be made and it must be ensured that the untreated effluents and solid wastes are not discharged into the water or on the beach.

#### Compliance:

At present the volume of solid waste as food waste is too low. The project proponent has been handling and managing all type of waste with utmost care. The published Rules for Municipal solid waste, 2016, is being implemented for proper management of waste. To treat the solid waste, the project proponent will install biobin for bio degradable waste. The end product manure can be used in garden. STP will be installed to reuse the waste water generated from the project site. The water from STP will be used for landscaping, flushing, cooling and other purpose. No waste will let out to public stream or to beach. All type of wastes ie E waste, hazardous waste will be handled as per rules and guidelines of Govt. of India published in 2016.

	achieved. Installation and operation of DG sets shall comply with

#### Compliance:

To makeup energy requirement, the project proponent will use DG sets for power back up during its operational phase. To reduce the sound generated from the DG set and to achieve 25 dB(A) a well designed acoustic enclosures will ensure. The installation and operation of DG sets will comply with the guidelines of SPCB. The project proponent will try to use low sulpher diesel in DG sets to reduce the carbon emission. At present a small DG set is using with the capacity of 62.5 kVA for backup power. This DG set is also having adequate enclosures to reduce noise.

15 Disposal of muck during construction phase should not create Complied any adverse effect on the neighboring communities and be disposed taking the necessary precautions for general safety and health aspects of people, only in approved sites with the approval of competent authority.

#### Compliance:


The project proponent had taken care of disposal of muck during its piling time of construction phase. The muck does not create any adverse effect on the neighboring communities. All necessary precautions had taken for general safety and health aspects of people. Since the number of piling was less the amount of generated muck was also too low.

16 Any hazardous waste generated during construction phase, shall complied be disposed off as per applicable rules and norms with necessary

#### approvals of the State Pollution Control Board.

#### Compliance:

The project proponent has placed appropriate waste bins in project site to collect hazardous waste. At present in construction phase the main hazardous waste is spent oil and oil filters which are being handled properly. The instant project is for hotel cum resort project therefore the generation of hazardous waste will be low. The expected hazardous wastes are used oil, oil filters, paint tins, will be handed over to recyclers approved by Pollution Control Board. The handling and management of hazardous waste will be in tune with the Hazardous Waste Management and Handling Rules, 2016.



#### II. Operation Phase

01A 2% of 'the Cost of the project shall be apportioned for<br/>environment protection and conservation measures to be spent<br/>by the project proponent towards fulfilling its Corporate<br/>Environmental Responsibility (CER) during the currency of the<br/>project. Proper record and account of measures taken should be<br/>maintained and should also be submitted to the CZMA.Noted

#### Compliance:

The instant project is under construction stage. The project proponent will spend 2% of the project cost for environment protection and conservation measures. The CER will be implemented under the OM dated 01-05-2018 issued by Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change. A proper record for CER and its account of measures taken will be maintained and will be submitted to the CZMA. The project proponent is intending to implement CER activities in its operational phase. However the project proponent has given Rs. 50,000 for Kerala Chief minister's covid-19 relief fund vide cheque no. 632913 on 05/05/2021.

02 The quantity of fresh water usage, water recycling and rain water Will be harvesting shall be measured and recorded to monitor the water complied balance as projected by the project proponent. The record shall be submitted to the Regional Office, MoEF&CC along with six monthly monitoring reports.

#### Compliance:

To monitor the water usage, recycling and rain water harvesting, water meters will be installed at relevant places. The project will collect rain water in its maximum. STP will install with adequate capacity to recycle the waste water. The monitoring data will be recorded in hotel cum resort office which will be sent to Regional Office of MoEF & CC along with six monthly monitoring reports.

## 03Solid waste shall be collected, treated and disposed in<br/>accordance with the Solid Waste (Management) Rules, 2016.Will be<br/>Complied

#### Compliance:

As part of solid waste management, the solid waste can be divided in to two; Bio degradable and Non - bio degradable wastes. The bio degradable waste will be handled through colour coded bin to collect. The segregated waste will be dump in to bio-bins installed. The end product from bio-bins will be manure which can use in garden.

The non bio- Degradable waste will also collect through colour coded bins and keep in a designated place. This will be sold to local vendors for recycling. The collection handling and disposal will be in tune with Municipal Solid waste Management and handling Rules 2016.

#### Compliance:

The project proponent has provided parking facility for the instant construction of hotel cum resort project. The driveway is planned with 6 meters. The project proponent will implement the parking plan as submitted at competent authority. The copy of submitted parking plan is attached as **Annexure No.15**.

#### Compliance:

To conserve water and to reuse used water the project proponent will install STP for recycling the waste water generated from the project site. The project proponent will engage with the STP supplier and a NABL accredited laboratory for regular maintenance to meet the effluent discharge standers laid down in the Kerala State Pollution Control Board.

# 06The green belt of the adequate width and density preferably with<br/>local species along the periphery of the plot shall be<br/>as to provide protection against particulates and noise.Will be<br/>Complied

#### Compliance:

To reduce noise and air pollution the project will plant various species including local species as green belt with adequate width. Since it is a Hotel cum resort project, the proponent is planning to plant various saplings along the periphery of the project to enhance the aesthetic value and biodiversity of the project site. The details of proposed species will be given once the landscaping plan finalized.

07Rain water harvesting system from roof run-off and surface runWillbeoff, shall be installed. .Before recharging the surface run off, pre-<br/>treatment must be done to remove suspended matter, oil and<br/>grease. The bore well for rain water recharging should be kept at<br/>least 5m above the highest ground water table.Willbe

#### Compliance:


The project proponent will harvest the rain water from roof top. The collection of surface run off is not mentioned in the EMP. The rain water harvesting through recharge pits is not feasible due to the location of high ground water table within the site. Since there is no harvesting of surface runoff the project didn't construct chamber for pre – treatment to remove suspended matter. The PP started to construct the rain water harvesting tank in the instant project.

08Energy conservation measureslike installationofCFLsWillbe/TFLs for the lighting the areas outside the building should beCompliedintegral part of the project design and should be in place beforeproject commissioning. Use CFLs and TFLs should be properlyComplexcollected and disposed off/sent for recycling as per the prevailingComplex

guidelines/rules of the regulatory authority to avoid mercury contamination. Use of solar panels may be done to the extent possible.

#### Compliance:

The project proponent will try to implement the guidelines of BEE for energy conservation. As part of energy conservation, the project proponent will use a wide range of LED and CFL lights. The project will install solar panels in operational phase of the hotel cum resort project. The discarded LEDs/CFIs/TFLs will be properly collected and disposed off for recycling as per the prevailing guidelines to prevent mercury contamination. The accurate details will be informed ones it finalized.

01The funds earmarked for environmental protection measures shallNotedbe kept in separate account and shall not be diverted for otherpurpose. Year-wise expenditure shall be reported to this Ministryand its concerned Regional Office.

#### Compliance:

The project proponent has submitted an environment Management Plan. As part of Environment protection, the project proponent will initiate measures like green area development, installation of STP, Construction of Rain water harvesting tanks, spraying of water to arrest the dust, Energy conservation etc. The details of expenditure will be given once the project started. #### Compliance:

As part of environment protection, the project proponent will assure to execute all possible measures stipulated in CRZ clearance. The project proponent will keep files regarding activities executed in project site for environment sustainability. The project will extend all support to the officials from the regional of MoEF&CC for their monitoring. The Project proponent has submitted a complete set of all documents to the regional office of MoEF&CC.

Incremental pollution loads on the<br/>ambient air and noise quality should be closely monitored during<br/>construction phase. Adequate measures should be made to<br/>reduce ambient air and noise level during construction phase, so<br/>as to conform to the stipulated standards by CPCB / SPCB.Complied

#### Compliance:

Since it is a hotel cum resort project there will be no sound generating activity from the project site. Ambient noise levels are conformed to residential standards both during day and night as per Noise Pollution (Control and Regulation) Rules, 2000. To reduce pollution load on ambient air and noise various mitigation measures will be implemented by the Project proponent. To confirm the limits, the proponent is conducting regular environmental monitoring by a NABL accredited laborotary. The copy of the monitoring result of ambient air, noise and water is attached as **Annexure No. 10, 11 & 12.** Water sprinkling, green cover, appropriate enclosures are some of the measures taken by the proponent to reduce ambient noise and air pollution.


